ETI Names Ron Baker President and CEO

Admiral Bobby R. Inman Assumes Chairmanship of Board

AUSTIN, Texas – December 12, 2005 - Evolutionary Technologies International, Inc. (ETI), a leading provider of enterprise data integration solutions, today announced the promotion of Ronald E. Baker to president and CEO, effective January 1, 2006. Baker has also been named to the board of directors. He was previously chief financial officer and chief operations officer.

Ron has demonstrated that he can rapidly and profitably scale a technology-focused business operation in a competitive market. He is uniquely qualified to continue to drive the momentum that ETI is experiencing right now in the data integration market.”

He previously served as a director of the Bank Street Group, a full-service investment banking firm and was formerly executive vice president and CFO of LiveWorld Inc., where he engineered the successful turnaround of the publicly traded company. Baker was also a founder and executive vice president of OnAir Streaming Networks, later sold to Loudeye Technologies. He holds a M.B.A. with honors from the University of Mississippi and undergraduate degrees in economics and engineering technology from Louisiana Tech University.
