U.S. Department of Defense Teams with ETI

ETI Solution® Software Deployment Will Connect More Than 43,000 Users
to over 700 Databases Across the Globe

AUSTIN, Texas – August 22, 2005 - Evolutionary Technologies International, Inc. (ETI), a leading provider of enterprise data integration solutions, today announced that the U.S. Department of Defense (DoD) Standard Procurement System Joint Program Management Office (SPS-JPMO) has implemented ETI Solution software as the standard platform for legacy-to-XML data transformation for the Standard Procurement System (SPS). The SPS is an automated contracting system that standardizes procurement processing across the DoD.

The SPS application, known as Procurement Desktop Defense (PD2), today is used by over 23,000 procurement officers for buying everything from office supplies to battleships. It is the first and only DoD-wide XML-based standard business system ever used by the combined armed forces – the Army, Navy, Air Force, and Marine Corps, as well as 13 DoD agencies and the logistics, acquisition and financial management communities.

By the end of the program's full deployment in 2006, the application will be web-enabled and will include more than 43,000 users at approximately 350 military facilities interfaced to more than 700 legacy applications across the globe. It is one of the largest service-oriented architectures (SOA) in the world.

“The automatic documentation alone is worth the cost of the product,” said Amy Taylor, Technical Division Chief, SPS-JPMO. “The documentation, the ability to capture specifications, and the ability to track to closure issues related to those specifications, are all key to our process now. These features ensure we always have visibility into the latest changes made to our integrations and that we won't have to reverse-engineer our interfaces in the future.”

“Of course it's important that ETI Solution speeds the integration of legacy systems with SPS, but the real business value is the visibility it gives us into the Department's business rules – documenting how we translate our common data elements into those unique legacy business processes currently being used across all the Services,” said Gino Magnifico, SPS Deputy Program Manager.

ETI will continue to support the SPS-JPMO on upcoming projects as the DoD plans for the next fiscal year.
